Scout 1: In two days, Friday the eleventh of November is the day that we celebrate Veteran's Day. You might know of it only as a day to get off from school, or think about military veterans in your family, but veteran's day has quite a lot more meaning to it. Veteran's Day first came into being on November 11, 1919 when President Woodrow Wilson started the new national holiday then known as "Armistice day." He said "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations..."

Scout 2: Though Armistice or Veteran's day was originally created to honor world peace it was made a national holiday in 1938 to honor mainly the veterans of WWI. However, this designation was changed in 1954 after WWII and the Korean War. It was then on June first, 1954 that "Armistice" Day was that it was changed to Veteran's Day, a day to recognize and honor all veterans. Please, will everyone bow your heads in silence to respect all of the veterans that have served, and died for our country.
