What To Bring: If staying in shelter: Set of dry clothes (light, loose layers) & day pack as if you got lost hiking. Day pack should have an energy bar, water, fire starting kit, emergency blanket, pocket knife, personal first aid kit, emergency bivy.

Boys attempting the overnight will be in shelters in teams of two for 6 hours without a sleeping bag Saturday night.

If staying in cabin: don't forget first aid kit, pocket knife and fire starting kit.

Daily Itinerary: Scouts will spend the day on Saturday on various Wilderness survival skill sessions and competitions, learning first aid, navigation, shelter building, and other survival skills. Older scouts may sleep overnight in shelters built during the day.
